Project Summary	A project that challenges people to go without/reduce single-use plastic for the entire month of June 2018.
Aims/objectives of project	 To encourage people to eliminate or to reduce their 'single-use plastic footprint'. To encourage people to think before they buy a single-use plastic product. To encourage people to buy alternatives to single-use plastics.

We were assessing people's attitudes to single-use plastic and if they were able to reduce/eliminate it over this one month trial. Participants decreased the amount of single-use plastic bough/used over this one month trial. Please see Appendix 1 Survey Results.

Target audience	MEA Employees (18+)
Successes	 70 people signed up; The participants are spread out throughout the borough; and The majority of people have agreed to change their ways in terms of plastic use, e.g. Cutting down on the amount of straws that are used, using a 'bag for life' when shopping (See Appendix 1 for Survey Results).
Failures	 Engaging more staff to participate. Better capture of single-use plastic reduction count.
